DATES AND LOCATION

CDPHE's Office of Public Health Practice, Planning, and Local Partnerships (OPHP) is co-hosting an in-person summit with the Colorado Association of Public Health Officials (CALPHO) **for LPHA Executive Directors on Tuesday and Wednesday, May 16th and 17th, 2023**. FORMAT

In Person only. There will **not** be a hybrid component to this event. There have been few opportunities for Executive Directors to meet and engage in person for some time. This format is in direct response to multiple requests from ED's to gather in person.

The first day's agenda will include information sharing and conversation with CDPHE directors and program staff, as well as opportunities for networking, learning from each other, and socializing. Day two will be led by CALPHO and will focus on public health transformation topics, including local public health data modernization, workforce development, and funding and financing.
